Help us keep our young people safe by adhering to our Safeguarding & Professional Boundaries policy. Keep in touch with us and please provide us with any feedback so we can constantly improve or volunteering programme! A full induction pack will be given to each volunteer which will contain all the information you need to start as a Hunslet Club Volunteer.

## **Training and Support**

Induction Training, On-the-job training alongside our trained and experienced staff, One-to-one meetings with our volunteer coordinator, Group CPD training.

All we require is to let us know when you are able to volunteer and let us know as soon as you become aware of any changes that might mean you are late or cannot attend. We require enthusiastic individuals that are happy working alongside young people and want to get the most out of their roles.
